



*If You Bring It, We Will Stamp!*

**1. What is the Passport Program?** An incentive program sponsored by and managed by the Campus Activities Board to encourage student participation in extracurricular activities offered by WCCC.

**2. What activities are included in the Passport Program?** All Campus Activities Board events; all academic workshops sponsored by ACT 101 & Trio/SSS; One Home Athletic game for each team; Student events held at education centers planned by the center coordinators; major cultural events sponsored by College Committees; Spring Leadership Conference, Blood Drives; SGA Events such as Awareness Fair and Club Fair; Events requested to be included by other student organizations or faculty members such as Black History Month events, guest lecturers, concerts, etc.

**3. How will this program be run?** Students will be given a small booklet designed to work as a passport at events. Upon attending they will receive a stamp in their booklet for the event. At the end of each semester, students will be eligible for large prize drawings based on the number of events they attend.

**4. How will the stamping work?** At most events, a CAB member will sit at a table with signs, program information and a special stamp. Each student will come on their own to have their passport stamped. If they do not have their passport with them, an IOU coupon will be given and they may come to the Student Activities office at any time to have their passport updated or do so at a later event.

**5. How do students become enrolled in the program and obtain their passports?** The Campus Activities Board will utilize Club Fair and all their events to reach students. Education Center Coordinators will be cooperating with the program by having passports available at each center for those students. Passports are available in the Student Activities Office or Students may also request a passport via email and one will be mailed out to them. Email to [CAB@my.wccc.edu](mailto:CAB@my.wccc.edu)

**6. How will the incentive be managed?** A "Passport Party" will be held at the end of each semester. Student need not be present to win their prizes, but must have turned their passport into the Student Activities Office prior to the party. Students may drop off, mail in or attend the party in person. At the party, all passports will be examined and an opportunity to update your passport with IOU coupons will be given. Students will then be entered into tiered prize drawings based on the number of events they have attended. For example, if a student attends just one event, they will be eligible for the first level of prizes. If a student attends ten events, they will be eligible for the first, second and third levels of prizes. All prizes will be given out by random drawing of the student's names that are eligible. There will be four levels of prizes.

**7. What will the prizes consist of?** The first and second levels of prizes will consist of donated gift certificates and merchandise from local businesses, such as a free food from McDonalds. The Campus Activities Board members will work throughout the semester to collect these prizes. The third tier will consist of five prizes valued at \$100.00 each. The top tier, or grand prize level, will consist of two prizes valued at \$500.00 each. Students will not need to be present at the party to claim their prizes.
